Office Hours Act

CONSIDERED THE **3RD** DAY IN THE MONTH OF **FEBUARY** IN THE YEAR **2026**

SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS AND PRECISIONS.

- (a) Office Hours (OH) are times when students can ask questions to the OH hosts.
- (b) Naming in this legislation is not binding, and Senators may still host unofficial OHs.

SECTION 2. OFFICE HOURS.

- (a) The Executive Branch must ensure at least 3 hours of OHs per semester are hosted.
 - (a) OHs are staffed and located at Executive Branch discretion within reason.
 - (b) Senators may be invited to help run OHs but are not required to participate
- (b) The Executive must publish student attendance numbers for each OH session.

SECTION 3. CASEWORK SERVICES.

- (a) Casework services that Senators or Executives provide to students are considered official.

SECTION 4. PUBLICATION.

- (a) OHs must be listed on the main page of the student government website.
 - (a) Event details must be kept current; the Executive is still responsible if delegated.
- (b) A post should be created on social media promoting OHs.
- (c) During OHs, digital signage displaying directions to them is required, if feasible.
